Gen: 18:1-15

2.0 Preambles

As Abraham walked faithfully within the covenant and before the Lord, his relationship with God lifted to new dimensions. Beside his earlier experiences of vision and voices, the God head physically visited him in human presentation! Even at that level presentation, Abraham still worshiped the LORD with quality offering which was honoured. Every divine visitation comes either with reward or judgment, in this case with Abraham God left Abraham with the reward of the Promise. Sarah will conceive and bear a son *indeed* and **heir of the Covenant**.
