**At the twilight of his days Abraham knew he must make solid plans to hand over the baton of the Covenant to his son, Isaac. He ensured that Isaac got a wife not from among the Canaanites but rather from his own roots in Mesopotamia. It would take the child of Promise and the son indeed to move the sanctity of the Covenant of God beyond Abraham.**
