2.0 Preambles

Immediately after Terah's death, Abram moved with Sarai and Lot out of Haran, toward Canaan, in further obedience to the earlier commandment from Him, in Ur of the Chaldees: at which point, he was 75years old. While in Canaan and in the midst of the Canaanites, God appeared to Abram the second time , to re-confirm the Promise to him. There in Canaan , Abram built an **altar** unto the Lord, "*in the plains of Moreh near Sichem*" He moved from the plains of **Moreh** unto the **Mountains**, where he sojourned his **tents**, with his household.
