1.0 Preambles

Egypt might have brought “*survival*” and “*riches*” to Abram, it was certainly a major distraction to his spiritual walk with God. His restoration from Egypt back to Canaan returned him to the abandoned primary starting-blocks of the place of the altar and the place where his tents had been, in the beginning. The challenge of the imported riches from Egypt into Canaan was soon to bring conflicts between Abram and Lot. The separation between them was imminent for Abram to focus and progress in God. Abram separated unto the difficult terrains of the mountains, away from Lot who headed to the green plains of Jordan.

2.0 Discussions / Interactions

- Discuss how Abram’s restoration to Canaan proved that his Egyptians sojourn was retardation in his spiritual walk.
- “..... unto the place where his tent had been at the beginning,..... Unto the place of the altar” Gen:13vs 3&4. What does Abram’s “*beginning*” in Canaan mean to God?
- Can the management of our riches and resources be a material distraction to our spirituality?
- Relate the respective separation of Abram and Lot in prophetic terms
