

The Encounter With Saul Of Tarsus

The testimony of the Lord Jesus Christ is divine yet no vessel is too vile for him to use as a tool in the work of redemption. His disposition in the work of the father can only typify the divine love of God, for all which is without blemish against human reason and logic. The Lord Jesus Christ found the embattled Saul of Tarsus (an avowed enemy of the Saints) to be a perfect chosen vessel for the work. It was the case of the detested *stone* being chosen to be the *cornerstone*.

“Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God...” 1 John 3 vs 1.

The encounter immediately transformed the enemy into a willing son. The testimonies of our encounter with the Lord Jesus Christ must produce brokenness, willingness and availability to do the will of the Father, circumstances notwithstanding.
